ORDER

On October 24, 2008, a contracting officer for the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Land Management issued a decision terminating for cause a contract awarded to appellant, Larry Barham, for the harvesting of Douglas Fir and Western Hemlock cones from selected trees located in an orchard in Oregon. The contracting officer's decision also assessed excess reprocurement costs in the amount of \$4961.04. Appellant filed a timely appeal.

Thereafter, counsel for respondent advised the Board that the parties had settled their dispute and that appellant would provide the Board with a letter seeking to withdraw the appeal and the agency would submit documentation of the canceled debt. Appellant has filed a letter asking to withdraw his appeal and the Government has filed documentation

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showing that the debt has been extinguished and that the terms of the settlement have been fully performed.

In accordance with the request of the parties, this appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
