ORDER

Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin / Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School Board (the Tribe) appealed a determination of an education line officer of the Bureau of Indian Education that "[t]he school used [fiscal year 2007] federal awards to support prior year deficit spending."

Before the appeal was filed, the Tribe had asked the education line officer to reconsider his determination. The officer complied with the request and has now withdrawn

the determination. He has concluded that the money in question was used "to cover allowable expenses." The Tribe has consequently asked the Board to dismiss the appeal.
