The Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans (S&WB) asked the Board to arbitrate a dispute between it and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) arising out the S&WB's request for a public assistance grant under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5172 (2006), for reimbursement of costs incurred as a result of Hurricane Katrina.

On December 10, 2010, the Board received a letter from FEMA stating that the two project worksheets, which were the subject of this arbitration, have been obligated. The parties have advised that they have executed a settlement agreement and, therefore, are requesting that the Board dismiss the arbitration claim.

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Accordingly, this arbitration claim before this Board is dismissed.
