Diamondhead Water and Sewer District (DWSD) asked the Board to arbitrate a dispute between it and the Federal Emergency Management Agency arising out of DWSD's request for a public assistance grant under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5172 (2006), to fund the relocation of DWSD's wastewater treatment plant as part of DWSD's complete replacement of the plant, as well as temporary repairs required to keep the plant operational until completion of the new plant.

The parties have filed a joint stipulation to dismiss this case with prejudice in accordance with the terms set forth in their settlement agreement, with all parties to bear their own costs.
