Pearl River Community College (PRCC) asked the Board to arbitrate a dispute between it and the Federal Emergency Management Agency arising out of PRCC's request for a public assistance grant under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5172 (2006). PRCC sought funds to replace Lamar Hall on its campus that was damaged as a result of Hurricane Katrina.

The parties have executed and filed a settlement agreement resolving all issues related to this arbitration. The parties have filed a joint stipulation to dismiss the arbitration with prejudice.
