On December 16, 2009, Charleston Marine Containers, Inc. (CMCI) appealed the final decision of a General Services Administration contracting officer denying its claim for additional costs under contract number GS–027-0205N to supply shipping containers to various federal government agencies. On January 4, 2011, CMCI filed a request to dismiss the appeal with prejudice, stating that the parties have fully settled and resolved the dispute at issue.
