ORDER

An awarding official of the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Indian Education determined that questioned costs in the amount of \$46,280 must be repaid to the Bureau by the Standing Rock Community Grant School. The School appealed this determination.

The parties have now resolved their differences. After the School provided additional information to the Bureau, the awarding official acknowledged that the School had supported the costs and that no money need be repaid. The parties have asked the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
