<u>ORDER</u>

Dr. Lewis J. Goldfine, appellant in these cases, filed an appeal alleging that the Social Security Administration wrongfully terminated a blanket purchase agreement, and a call order issued under that agreement, for medical consulting services. The case was docketed as CBCA 2549. Appellant later filed a second appeal seeking monetary damages in the amount of \$72,068, which was docketed as CBCA 2795.

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On November 27, 2012, appellant filed a stipulation of dismissal with prejudice, stating that the parties have settled the cases.

Accordingly, the appeals are hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
