Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory Board, Inc., dba Kinlani (Kinlani) appealed a decision of an awarding official of the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Indian Education which determined that \$2,712,819 in costs for which Kinlani sought reimbursement were unallowable.
