Xerox Corporation claimed that it was entitled to be paid \$1,049,072.47 for equipment, supplies, and services it provided to the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Los Angeles, California, under a contract with the Department of Veterans Affairs. The parties have now filed a stipulation of dismissal, stating that they have settled the matters in dispute and request dismissal of the appeal.
