ORDER

The Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin/Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School Board appealed a determination of a Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) education line officer that \$509,990 in 2010 Indian School Equalization Program funds were improperly applied to reduce the Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School's operating deficit and must therefore be repaid to BIE.

CBCA 3141-ISDA 2

The parties have now resolved their dispute by agreeing that only \$110,894 of these funds must and will be repaid. The parties have filed a joint motion for dismissal of the appeal with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
