On November 2, 2012, the Board received a notice of appeal from MKB Constructors, a Joint Venture, concerning its contract, HSCG50-11-C-PJT049, with the Department of Homeland Security, Coast Guard. The contracting officer had denied the contractor's certified claim for additional compensation relating to cargo wharf repair in Kodiak, Alaska. The parties resolved this dispute through informal means, informing the Board on January 15, 2013, that a full and final settlement has occurred. According to the request of the parties, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** the appeal.
