ORDER

On August 28, 2012, the Board received a notice of appeal from AMX Veterans Specialty Services, LLC (contractor), disputing the contracting officer's denial of its mistake in bid claim under its contract, VA257-C-0581, with the Department of Veterans Affairs (agency). The contractor seeks \$1,072,729, for what it describes as mistakes in its bid. It seeks contract reformation to reflect what it contends is the intended pricing for the work required by the specifications. On August 27, 2013, the parties informed the Board that they have settled the dispute and jointly stipulated that the appeal should be dismissed with prejudice. According to the request of the parties, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** the appeal.
