On March 13, 2008, and October 13, 2009, the Board received notices of appeal from Carmon Construction Company (contractor) concerning its contract, LGL05C00005, with the Department of Homeland Security (agency) for the renovation of building 681, Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, in Glynco, Georgia.
