## <u>ORDER</u>

In these five appeals, received and docketed on October 22, 2014, the Tule River Indian Tribe of California sought contract support costs for five fiscal years, under Indian Self-Determination Act contracts with the Department of Health and Human Services. The parties resolved these disputes without formal proceedings. On November 25, 2014, the parties submitted to the Board a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice of each appeal, submitted pursuant to a settlement agreement between the parties. Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** these appeals.
