ORDER

The Yakutat Tlingit Tribe claimed entitlement to \$64,731 plus interest in underpaid contract support costs for fiscal years 2005 through 2008. A contracting officer of the Department of Health and Human Services' Indian Health Service denied the claims, and the Tribe appealed her decisions.

The parties have filed a joint stipulation of dismissal with prejudice, which states that the disputes between the parties as to these claims have been settled.
