## <u>ORDER</u>

The Department of the Interior's Bureau of Indian Education made grants to Sitting Bull School for the school's fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, and June 30, 2010. Following a review of audits of the grant funds, an awarding official of the Bureau determined that questioned costs in the amounts of \$41,899 for the 2009 fiscal year and \$212,298 for the 2010 fiscal year must be repaid to the Bureau by the school. The school appealed these determinations. We docketed the fiscal year 2009 matter as CBCA 3514-ISDA and the fiscal year 2010 matter as CBCA 3513-ISDA.

## CBCA 3513-ISDA, 3514-ISDA

The parties have now resolved their differences and have asked the Board to dismiss the appeals with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The appeals are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
