## CHADWICK, Board Judge.

Claimant sought review of a debt assessed by the agency, after an audit, in the amount of \$46, which he was reimbursed for obtaining personal accident insurance in connection with renting a vehicle for official travel. As the agency notes, personal accident insurance is categorically "not reimbursable" under the Federal Travel Regulation. 41 CFR 301-10.452 (2021); *see*, *e.g.*, *John C. Freeman*, CBCA 5977-TRAV, 18-1 BCA ¶ 37,155, at 180,863. Claimant suggests that the insurance "met the exception to the rule." The regulation contains no exception. Accordingly, we deny the challenge of the debt.
