This matter was docketed on November 10, 2008. On December 24, 2008, the agency, United States Army Corps of Engineers, notified the Board that it had computed claimant's entitlement. The agency reimbursed claimant, Charles W. Bell, \$9204.06. There remained a \$477.20 difference between what claimant asserted he was owed and what the agency found reimbursable.

The Board made several unsuccessful attempts to reach claimant to ascertain whether he wished to pursue the \$477.20 difference. On February 25, 2009, the undersigned issued an order to show cause, directing claimant to inform the Board, no later than March 20, 2009, whether he wished to pursue the \$477.20 difference between what claimant originally asserted was owed and the amount the agency found reimbursable. Claimant was also informed that a failure to respond timely to the order to show cause would be treated as an indication that claimant no longer wished to prosecute the matter.

Claimant did not respond to the order to show cause, and, accordingly, this claim is dismissed.
