ORDER

The General Services Administration (GSA) terminated for default a contract with Trautman's Painting (Trautman) for painting and lead paint mitigation at the Charles A. Halleck Federal Building and Courthouse in Lafayette, Indiana. The contractor appealed this decision.

In filing the appeal, Trautman asked that the termination be converted to one for the convenience of the Government with no costs to the contractor. As explained in a settlement agreement filed with the Board, GSA has agreed to make the conversion. GSA has moved the Board to dismiss the case, and Trautman has no objection to the motion.

Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED**.
