ORDER

On August 7, 2007, the parties filed with the Board their agreement to settle this appeal. Under the terms of their settlement agreement, appellant would pay respondent \$15,000, and respondent would convert its termination of appellant's contract for cause to a termination for convenience. Upon receipt of the parties' settlement agreement, the Board conferred with the parties in a telephone conference, and an understanding was reached that the parties would comply with the terms of their settlement agreement before the Board

dismissed this appeal with prejudice, and a suspension of proceedings for sixty days would be ordered for that purpose. Board's Conference Memorandum (Aug. 16, 2007) at 2.

On October 24, 2007, the parties filed a joint motion that advised the Board that they had complied with all of the terms of their settlement agreement, and they requested that the Board dismiss this appeal with prejudice.

Accordingly, this appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
