ORDER

On May 4, 2007, Logenix International, L.L.C. appealed a deemed denial of its Contract Disputes Act claim for \$849,478.41 under contract no. 267-0-00-05-00504-00 in connection with the alleged nonpayment by the Agency for International Development for health care kits. On December 21, 2007, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss with prejudice indicating that they had reached a settlement agreement and requesting that this case be dismissed with prejudice.
