ORDER

This appeal arose out of a contract between the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and Archaeologic USA, appellant, to do an archaeological survey of federally-owned land in Utah prior to the BLM undertaking a fuel reduction project. The dispute arose over the increased number of sites required to be surveyed. The Board has been advised by the parties that they have entered into a stipulation for settlement agreement and request that the Board dismiss this appeal with prejudice.
