ORDER

On May 26, 2009, Prism Point Technologies (contractor) filed a notice of appeal pursuant to the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. §§ 601-613, as amended (CDA). The contractor disputes the termination for cause of its contract, SS00-08-60009, with the Social Security Administration (Government). The parties engaged in discovery and discussions.

On February 1, 2010, the Board received from the contractor a motion to dismiss, because the contractor has decided that it will no longer pursue this appeal. The Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** this appeal.
