ORDER

On January 13, 2011, the Board received from Clark/Hunt, A Joint Venture--Nevada (contractor) a notice of appeal, docketed as CBCA 2264, concerning a denial of its claim arising under a contract, VA101CFM-C-003, with the Department of Veterans Affairs (agency). In particular, the contractor seeks \$715,981, said to represent the additional costs it incurred when the Government did not accept "equal" lighting fixtures in lieu of brand name products. The parties resolved questions of entitlement and quantum. On February 21, 2012, the Board received notice that the parties have resolved the dispute, such that the contractor seeks a dismissal with prejudice. Accordingly, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** this appeal.
