ORDER

Arch 1650 Partners, LP (Arch) filed appeals challenging two decisions issued by a General Services Administration (GSA) contracting officer regarding adjustments to rental payments under contracts for the lease by Arch to GSA of property in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The parties have informed the Board that they have settled their disputes and that consequent to the settlement, GSA has paid a sum of money to Arch. The parties have asked the Board to dismiss the appeals with prejudice.
