ORDER

B. S. Environmental Inc. was awarded a contract by the United States Coast Guard, an entity within the Department of Homeland Security, to provide grit removal services. The contractor claimed that it was entitled to be paid sums additional to the contract amount as compensation for unforeseen conditions the Coast Guard imposed on performance of the work. Dissatisfied with the contracting officer's decision on the claim, the contractor appealed her decision to the Board.

The parties have filed a stipulation for dismissal with prejudice which states that the appeal has been "fully settled and satisfied" and asks the Board to dismiss the appeal with prejudice.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
