ORDER

Amtek Enterprises, LLC, appealed the decision of a contracting officer of the Department of the Interior's National Park Service which granted only a small part of a claim in the amount of \$106,034.83. The claim had been brought under a contract for the design and construction of an on-site sewage facility at Big Bend National Park, Texas.

The parties have now entered into a settlement agreement which resolves all outstanding issues relating to the contract, and the appellant has moved the Board to dismiss the case with prejudice.

The motion is granted. The case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.**
