ORDER

Linc Government Services, LLC (Linc), claimed entitlement to \$77,217.61 plus overhead and profit stemming from work performed under a delivery order to design and build the Mammoth Spring (Arkansas) National Fish Hatchery. A contracting officer of the Department of the Interior's Fish and Wildlife Service denied the claim, and Linc appealed his decision to the Board.

Linc now informs us that the parties have settled the case. The company asks us to dismiss the appeal with prejudice.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
