ORDER

The Department of Veterans Affairs contracted with Saylor Construction, Inc. for construction to upgrade the urgent care and emergency room at the agency's health care facility in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The project was delayed due to agency actions, and the agency compensated the contractor for some of the damages which were claimed to have ensued. The contractor appealed from the contracting officer's decision which denied the remainder of the claim.

Following a mediation session conducted by Board Judge Harold D. Lester, Jr., the parties have entered into a settlement agreement and asked that the case be dismissed. The parties note in their joint motion that other claims may be made under this contract and that

any future claims are neither addressed in the settlement agreement nor affected by a dismissal of the case.

As requested by the parties, this case is **DISMISSED**.
