ORDER

On December 7, 2010, the Board received from IntelliMap, Inc. (contractor) a notice of appeal concerning its claim for \$1,724,799 in breach of contract damages arising under a purchase order, 2W-1394-WASA, placed by the Environment Protection Agency (agency). The contractor licensed a database to the agency. The contractor maintains that the agency failed to properly protect its database and failed to include safeguards to prevent a coordinated computer download of its confidential business information. On May 26, 2011, the parties filed a joint request seeking a dismissal with prejudice; they have resolved this dispute, with each party to bear its own costs and attorney fees. The Board grants the request; the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
