ORDER

The Department of Justice's Bureau of Prisons terminated for cause a contract with Addiction Recovery Services for community-based transitional drug abuse treatment and mental health treatment services in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The contractor appealed the agency's decision.

Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
