ORDER

In these twelve appeals, Chugachmiut sought contract support costs for various fiscal years, under Indian Self-Determination Act contracts with the Department of Health and Human Services. The parties resolved these disputes without formal proceedings. On October 20, 2014, the parties submitted to the Board a joint stipulation indicating that they had entered into a settlement agreement and stipulating to a dismissal with prejudice of each appeal.
