ORDER

On April 7, 2025, appellant, McKenzie Construction & Site Development, LLC (McKenzie), filed a notice of appeal with the Board, challenging a General Services Administration (GSA) contracting officer's decision denying McKenzie's claim for revision of its Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) evaluation under contract number 47PD0322D0012. Subsequently, on April 11, 2025, McKenzie filed a motion seeking to dismiss this appeal with prejudice, representing that the appeal is now moot because GSA has amended the CPARS evaluation and resolved the parties' dispute.

McKenzie's motion is granted. This appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
